

# RedFin Network

## Zen-Cart Payment Module

### Install Guide

#### Module Requirements

1. You must have a valid account with RedFin Network
2. Your site must establish an https connection to secure.redfinnet.com
3. cURL must be compiled in PHP (check with your web hosts)

#### New Files

[ZENHOME]/includes/modules/payment/redfin.php

[ZENHOME]/includes/languages/english/modules/payment/redfin.php

#### Set Up

When you unpacked the zip file, it created an /includes directory beneath the location that you unpacked to.

The new files have been placed under that /includes directory in the locations shown above.

These files need to be moved to the same locations on your Zen-Cart server.

Getting these files into their proper locations can be accomplished either via an FTP client program or through the file manager window if your server is local.

Once you've placed the new files, go to your Zen-Cart 'admin' panel, go to Modules --> Payment, click once on the RedFin Network link, and then click to Install.

When you've done that, click on 'Edit' and set up as follows:

1. **Enable Redfin Network Module** - Set to 'True'
2. **User Name** as provided to you by RedFin Network
3. **Password** as provided to you by RedFin Network
4. **Payment Zone** - **Set This to 'NONE'**.
5. **CURL Proxy IP Address** - If your provider requires the use of a CURL proxy, enter the full URL here, otherwise leave it set to none.
6. **Sort Order Of Display** - set to zero to make this module appear above other payment modules.
7. **Set Order Status** - leave set to Default or set to an order status of your choice.
8. Click **Update** and you're done installing here.

#### Additional Info

Make a complete site backup **before** installing this or any module into your live Zen-cart server. Run adequate testing **before** you put your account **Live** with RedFin Network.
